General Tour Information

Tours - all tours have professional guides on each bus – we've been promised sunshine and blue skies but parts of the bay get foggy at certain times of the day -- be sure to bring a jacket and layer clothing. Jerry Rosenthal/** was reminded of Mark Twain's comment the closest he ever came to freezing to death was one summer in San Francisco. Order a warm 57th sweat shirt or jacket for delivery at the reunion!

Friday: 9a: drive through San Francisco, Golden Gate Park and the Presidio, former headquarters of the US Sixth Army, cross the Golden Gate Bridge, 9:45a: stop at north view point for pictures, and continue on to the rugged dramatic hills of Marin County; on to Mt. Tamalpais State Park and the Muir Woods National Monument with optional gentle walk through the serenity of this cathedral like setting surrounded by some of the oldest and tallest trees in the world, the California redwoods. Gift shop and snack bar. 1p: arrive at quaint and charming community of Sausalito for lunch on your own at any number of restaurants with time to browse through many unique shops of this popular fishing village and artist colony. About 3p: optional 30 min ferry ride return on your own (abt \$7) for bus pick up on SF side. Return to hotel about 5 pm.

Saturday: 9a: short ride to Hiller Aviation Museum highlighting many historic achievements in flight native to Northern California. Gift shop and snack shop; several wheelchairs to borrow. 10:30: on to Filoli Gardens-docent led tour of the Golden Age of American garden design and country house architecture; or just relax and take in the magnificence against a backdrop of the northern Santa Cruz mountains. Gift shop and tea room. 1:15: Continue by bus over the coastal range to historic hi-way 1 and up the majestic scenic coast for lunch on your own at several restaurants seafood lovers/non seafood lovers menus (restaurant list and menu options will be provided) on the coast and if you like a gentle walk along the beach or just sit back and enjoy the glorious coastal scenery. A truly peaceful relaxing and scenic day. Return to hotel about 3 pm. (time to take the free trolley to downtown Burlingame or take BART trans for even more adventures)

Sunday: 9a: San Francisco city tour offers a myriad of views unmatched by few cities, a unique setting of hills and valleys almost surrounded by the Pacific ocean and SF bay is unmatched. Among the sights and stops will be: Cliff House, Coit Tower, SF/Oakland Bay Bridge, Japan Town; Ferry Building, Union Square, Civic Center, Palace of Fine Arts, Twin Peaks, Lombard Street, Treasure Island, Chinatown, Haight-Ashbury, Alamo Sq Victorian Homes, Pacific Heights, Nob Hill, and Union Sq. 1p: final stop at Fisherman's Wharf/Pier 39 for lunch on your own, shopping, cable cars, or harbor cruising if you like before returning to the hotel about 5 pm.

Wing Brunch – Fantastic entertainment by professional Dean Martin impersonator. Hilton award winning chefs preparing buffet breakfast items in addition to clam chowder, chicken alfredo, hangar steak, dessert.
